The newly relaunched Holocaust Reunion Project

The Holocaust Reunion Project is proud to announce its relaunch, marking a significant milestone in its mission to reunite Holocaust survivors with family. Launched in late 2022 as the DNA Reunion Project at the Center for Jewish History, the pilot program distributed over 1200 free DNA tests to survivors and their children, enabling scores of meaningful connections.
