Culver Street, Phoenix, AZ 85004. The US Embassy ordered Carl and Teresa Wilkens to evacuate Rwanda along with thousands of other expatriates and UN soldiers. They chose not to obey. Teresa did take their children to safety however Carl stayed throughout the 3-month genocide. Wilkens will be exploring stories from this time as well as the 30-year journey since.
